

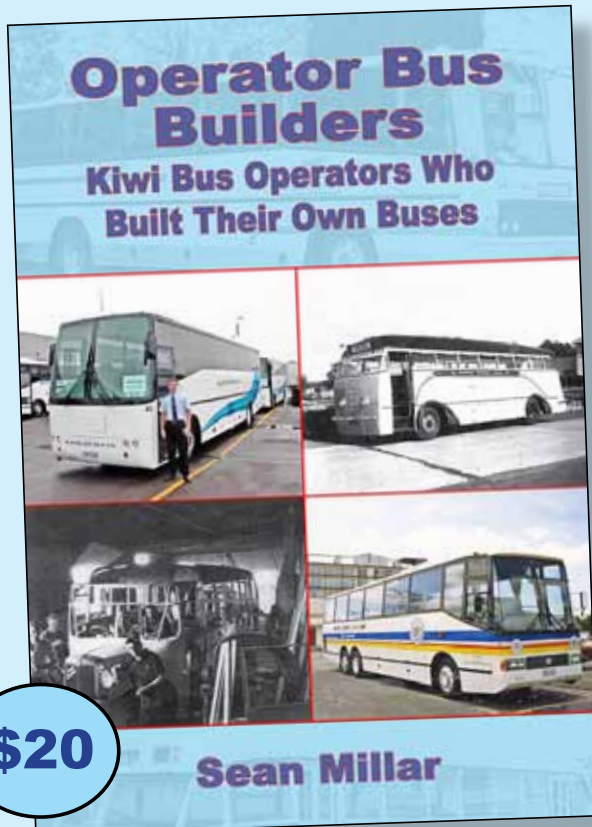

A fascinating and well-illustrated record of a seldom-mentioned aspect of New Zealand's industrial and transport history.

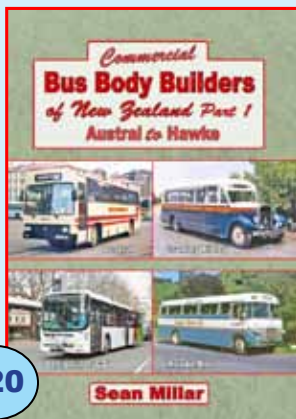
Many operator-builders, including the most prolific, Midland Coachlines of Christchurch, only built bodies. However some, including Mount Cook-Denning, also of Christchurch, and Auckland's Passenger Transport Co, also built chassis.

In recent years, the ready availability of cheap imported buses, has seen the decline of operator-builders leaving only Kaitaia-based Harrisons still active at the time of publication.

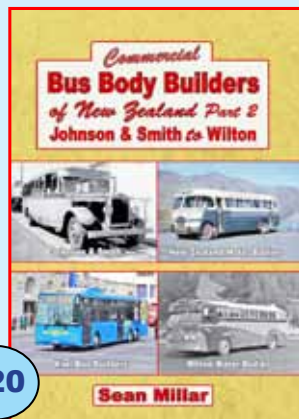

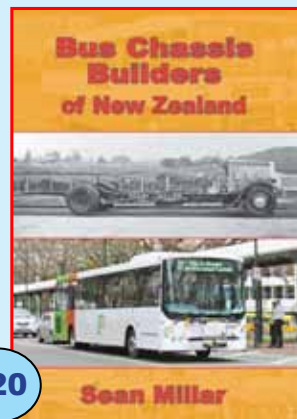
